## Program - Irene Rushworth & Judy Ferguson

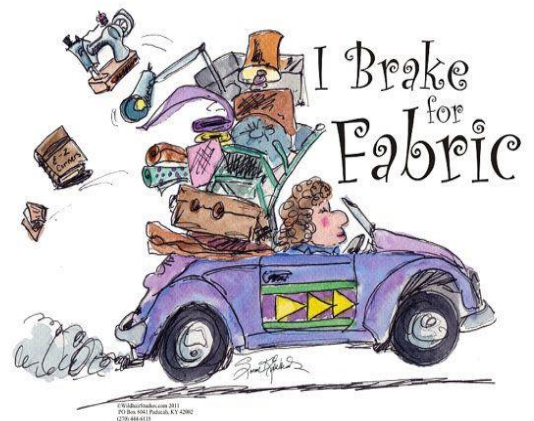
Our guest speaker for May is B. J. Reid

Focus on the three colors showcased in this image - **fresh green**, **tulip yellow** and **bleeding heart pink**.

The fabric can be tone on tone or polka dots on white of any one of those three colors.



Or a blender that includes all three like *Marblehead Butterflies are Free* by Ro Gregg for Paintbrush Studios.
