We are trying to set something up for October/November 2019 and we would like to get an idea if people would be interested.


It would be a "Learn and Give" style workshop.

They are both to be used for the border, it is up to you which one you prefer. They can be used all the way around your border or spread out however you wish.


You can check your color photo for an idea and you can look at my quilt at the meeting.
